# Background Information

The State Homeland Security Program issues grants on an annual basis to improve state and local efforts in responding to potential acts of terrorism and catastrophic events. Qualifying uses of the grant funds include purchasing advanced equipment and training.

The City of Corpus Christi is applying for \$138,750.75 from the FY27 State Homeland Security Grant Program.



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# Background Information

### **This grant will provide funding for:**

- 1) Bomb Squad – To purchase 2 up-to-date EOD 10E Bomb Suits.
- 2) Dive Team Search and Rescue – Updated navigation/electronic equipment for two boats.

Grant funds will be appropriated into the FY 27 Police Grants Fund upon award.



# Background Information

This grant is for a one-year period beginning September 1, 2026, through August 31, 2027.

The City has been awarded this grant for the past 23 years. Last year, the CCPD received \$215,009.32 from this grant for the purchase of one additional 2025 Ford F-450 Police response vehicle and one replacement Spartan Robot for the Corpus Christi Police Department's Bomb Squad.
