
BOARD DETAILS



The Building Standards Board hears appeals under the Building Standards and Housing Code, which shall be construed to secure the beneficial interests and purposes of safety, health, and general welfare, through structural strength, stability, sanitation, adequate light and ventilation, and safety to life and property from fire and other hazards incident to the construction, alteration, repair, removal, demolition, use and occupancy of buildings or structures.



COMPOSITION

Seven (7) members, three (3) members at-large of whom shall be residents of the City and home owners; one (1) shall be a lawyer, three (3) chosen from: realtor, architect, engineer, general contractor, home builder or building materials dealer. Appointed by the City Council for three-year staggered terms. Elects its own chairman.

CREATION / AUTHORITY

Section 13-23, Code of Ordinances. Ordinance No. 7506 - 3-3-65; Ord. No. 9811 - 6-24-70; Ord. No. 13546 - 1-05-77; Ord. No. 022423 - 11-28-95.

MEETS

Every other month on the 4th Thursday, 1:30 p.m., Council Chambers. The board shall meet within 30 days after notice of an appeal. Meetings are at City Hall. The Building Official or his designee shall keep a record of the business of this office. The records shall be open to public review.


