- Twenty-year Lease Agreement (2011-2021)
- Just Completed Third Full Year



Financial



Rounds of Golf – 79,395 (8,512 decrease)

Oso Beach 43,067 (4,914 decrease)

> Lozano 36,328 (3,598 decrease)

➤ National Average for a Public Course = 33,000

Total Revenue – \$2,798,611 (\$26,806 decrease)

Total Expenditures - \$2,549,792 (\$41,932 increase)

Net Operating Surplus - \$248,819 (\$68,738 decrease)

• City Share of Surplus - \$124,409 (\$9,370 decrease)

2013 Recap



- Financial
 - **>** \$ 248,819
 - ➤ Food and Beverage Sales, Merchandise Sales, Driving Range Revenues were up
 - More Non-Golf Functions (receptions, etc.)
 - Revenue per round 33.42 (up \$2.00 per round)
- Rounds of Golf
 - ➤ Down due to Weather 51 more bad weather days in 2013 than in 2012 primarily in Sept, Nov and Dec
- Improved Course Conditions
 - Bunkers
 - Lozano Pro Shop
