

Resolution amending the City’s FY 2020-2025 Infrastructure Management Plan work approach to focus more on street rehabilitation addressing more neighborhood streets at a faster pace

WHEREAS, on October 27, 2020, the Public Works Department of the City of Corpus Christi presented City Council with a five-year infrastructure management plan (“IMP”);

WHEREAS, the first two years of the IMP are fully planned and underway, projects scheduled for FY2021 are 85% complete and the projects scheduled for FY2022 are 55% complete;

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department has determined that in order to rehabilitate more residential streets in the City, they need to focus on rehabilitation and preventative maintenance on the remaining streets listed in the IMP for the remaining three years of the Program.

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Corpus Christi, Texas, that:

Section 1. The City Council specifically finds that the foregoing statements included in the preamble of this resolution are true and correct and adopts such findings for all intents and purposes.

Section 2. The City Council hereby adopts the Amended Five-Year Infrastructure Management Plan as attached hereto as “Exhibit A” and incorporated herein by reference.
