In 2026, 5 allegations have been submitted, one was closed due to insufficient evidence, and one was forwarded to the Corpus Christi Police Department. Three of the allegations are currently under review.

Legend (defined by the Association of Certified Fraud Examiners (ACFE)):

- Fraud: An intentional act for personal gain or to cause a loss to another party.
- Waste: The mismanagement or misuse of resources, often leading to a lack of value for money.
- Abuse: Occurs when there is an intentional and unacceptable use of grant funds or misuse of one's position.
