FY25 State & Local Cybersecurity Grant Program Awards

Background Information

The State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program is funded through the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency Management Agency. This grant opportunity provides funding to eligible state, local, and territorial (SLT) governments to manage and reduce systemic cyber risk, thus improving the security of critical infrastructure and improving the resilience of the services SLT governments provide their communities.

The City of Corpus Christi has received three grant awards totaling \$406,345.24, with a required cash match of \$81,269.05.

Background Information

Governance & Planning Grant

This grant will fund the additional development and implementation of an IT Business Continuity Plan that ensures rapid and efficient restoration of normal network operations following any event.



Background Information

Mitigation Grant

This grant will fund the purchase of cybersecurity software designed to support the City's ability to detect, investigate, and respond to cyber threats and prevent unauthorized access, attacks, and other malicious activities.



Background Information

Workforce Development Grant

This grant will fund the purchase of specialized training for the Information Technology department to ensure staff is equipped with the latest knowledge needed to protect and maintain critical systems.

Grant Implementation

Once grants have been approved and accepted, the IT Department will work with the Finance & Procurement Department to purchase the software, equipment, and training to complete the approved grant projects.

The grant period for all of the awarded grants is January 1, 2026 - December 31, 2026.
