This letter is to provide you an update on our involvement in the Schlitterbahn Upper Padre Water Resort being constructed in Corpus Christi, Texas by Henry and Sons Construction (general contractor), and owned by Upper Padre Partners, LP. Yesterday afternoon our Board of Directors approved two separate credit facilities, which in conjunction with a separate credit facility provided by Axys Capital, will be used to complete the project. IBC and Axys loan documents are currently being circulated for comment between the various parties, and we are hopeful for a closing within the next thirty days. The title company along with our borrower's council is currently gathering releases and dismissals on the various mechanics liens and lawsuits that have been filed. As an institution, IBC is still very excited to be a participant in the project, and it is important to note that construction has never stopped on the site.
