B. Public Comment

Eric Jaramillo, District 4, with Adopt-A-Beach, addressed the Committee to give information regarding upcoming beach clean-up events. He stated he also partners with Beautify Corpus Christi and the Texas General Land Office for these types of events. He wanted to pass this information along to PRAC as a partnership opportunity to attend these events and promote similar programs such as Adopt-A-Park.

Katie Galan, Lamar Park, with Beautify Corpus Christi, addressed the Committee to provide information on the groups efforts and how they can be used as a resource for local park revitalization projects. She gave information on a recent, large-scale park revitalization project that was completed at Dilworth Park. This project was executed with grant funds and sponsorships. They are currently working on a future maintenance project at Dilworth Park. She encouraged PRAC to partner with their volunteer base for smaller-scale projects. She believes this could be beneficial to help fill in funding gaps.
