Background Information

Resolution authorizing the submission of a grant application to the State of Texas under the Body-Worn Camera Grant Program.

The sworn officers that will be assigned the body-worn cameras are those who engage in field work. This means sworn officers that are assigned to traffic or highway patrol or otherwise regularly detain or stop motor vehicles, or primary responders who respond directly to calls for assistance from the public.

The City of Corpus Christi is requesting \$ 104,300.00 with a City cash match of \$ 34,767.00.

This grant will provide funding for:

- Body Worn Cameras and licenses (50)
- Magnetic mounts for cameras on officers (50)
- Five-year warranty (50)
- Single charging station, AC adapter to charge camera (5)

The grant period for this grant is September 1, 2025, through August 31, 2026.

Department will come back to Council for Ordinance approval and appropriation of funds.
