- Live Release (Cats): 649 (61.69%)



The Process



Step 1: Investigate

Animal Care Officers are dispatched to location to **verify violation**. Attempt to make contact with owner (if known) or witnesses.

Step 2: Notify

If contact is not successful, then a **Notice of Violation** is left at the location, outlining the procedure to bring compliance.

Step 3: Follow-up

Re-inspection determines if the violation(s) has been brought into compliance.

Step 4: Resolve

Compliance is the best outcome. Owners who do not comply, could face removal of the animal and further citations.
