

## Resolution

**Authorizing the City Manager or designee to submit a grant application in the amount of \$645,331 to the Automobile Burglary Theft Prevention Authority (ABTPA) to continue the motor vehicle theft enforcement grant within the Police Department for Year 14 with a City cash match of \$485,161, in-kind match of \$52,045, and program income match of \$7,687 for a total project cost of \$1,190,224 and authorizing the City Manager or the City Manager's designee to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to submit a grant application in the amount of \$645,331 to the Automobile Theft Prevention Authority (ATPA) to continue the motor vehicle theft enforcement grant within the Police Department for Year 14 with a City cash match of \$485,161, in-kind services of \$52,045, and a program income match of \$7,687, for a total project cost of \$1,190,224 and authorizing the City Manager or the City Manager's designee to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant.

**SECTION 2.** In the event of the loss or misuse of these funds, the City of Corpus Christi assures that the funds will be returned, in full, to the Automobile Theft Prevention Authority.
