Ordinance authorizing execution of all documents necessary to accept, amend, and appropriate a grant contract for the Public Health Emergency Preparedness (“PHEP”) Grant from the Texas Department of State Health Services appropriating \$240,003.00 into the Health Grants Fund to provide funding activities in support of the PHEP Cooperative Agreement from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention; and amending the operating budget.

# Background and Staff Recommendation

---

- Hazards-PHEP Grant Program
  - To be used to provide for personnel costs, supplies, and other expenses to improve the capabilities of the Corpus Christi-Nueces County Public Health District to prepare, respond and recover from natural and man-made disasters, in collaboration with community partners in Nueces County. For surveillance, investigations and reporting of Texas Notifiable Conditions including food-borne, water-borne, zoonotic and multidrug resistant infections for Nueces County residents.
  - July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023
- Total Operating budget is \$240,003.00 with zero expected Program Income
  - There is no fiscal impact. The grant requires \$24,000.00 match. All positions are 100% grant funded.
- Staff Recommendation: Approval of the two reading ordinance.
