Changes to Ordinance Violations



- Citations updated
- Summons mailed
- Plea options on reverse
- Option to pay online or by phone
- Scheduled within 2 days of entry
- Scheduled 3 weeks out or less



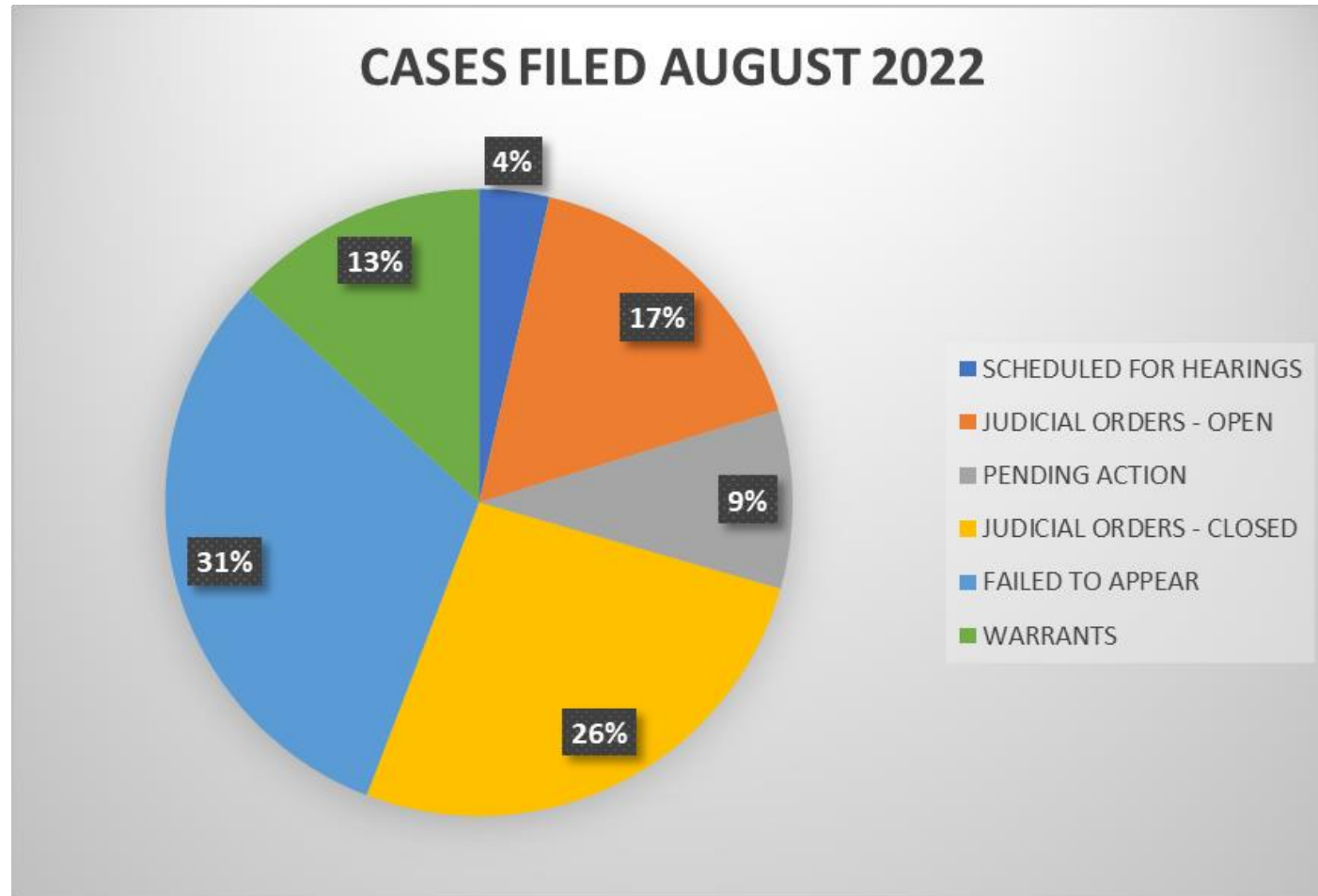
Case Scheduling



- Court calendars opened every 30 days
- Calendar addressed consistently based on case load
- Example: Water Ordinance violations
- All cases scheduled within 3 weeks

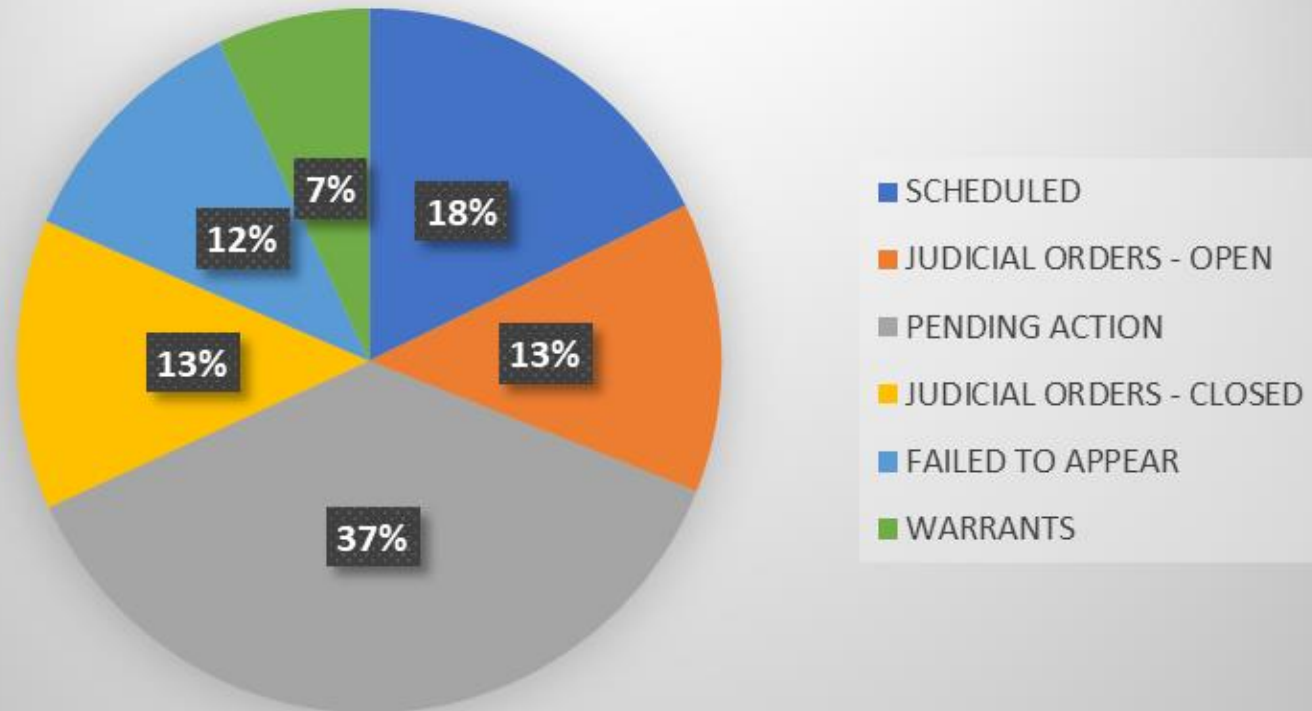




September Case Action

• Year:	2021	2022
• Filed:	58,526	70,757
• Closed:	34,368	84,779
• Variance:	58.72%	119.82%



Changes to Payment Plans



- Payment plan schedule
 - Minimum \$50 monthly payment
 - Inability to afford the minimum payment
 - Payments must be paid monthly
 - Scheduled to a Fail to Comply
 - Warrant issued
 - Text messages sent

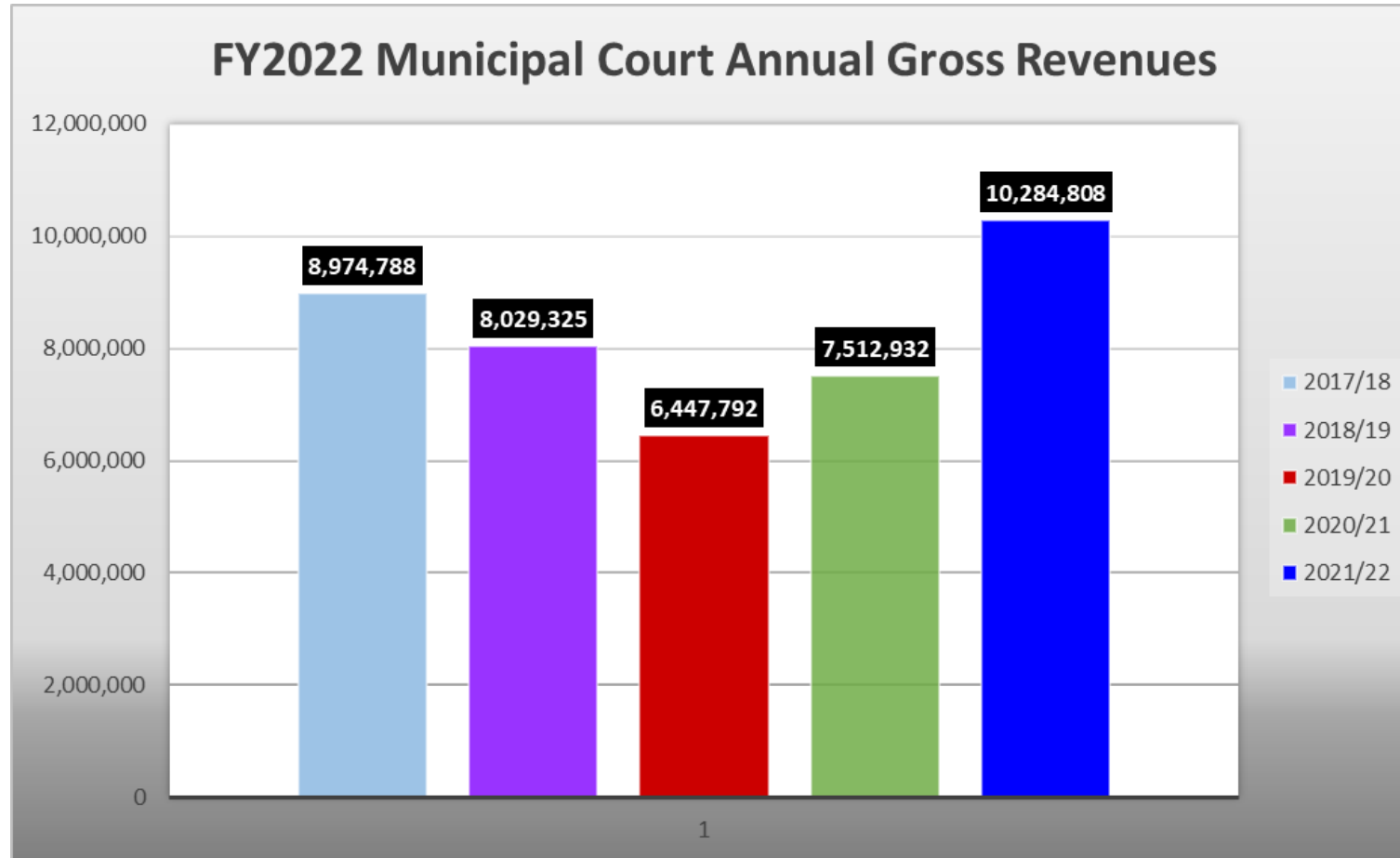
Warrant Resolution Month

- # of Customers visiting: 7,001

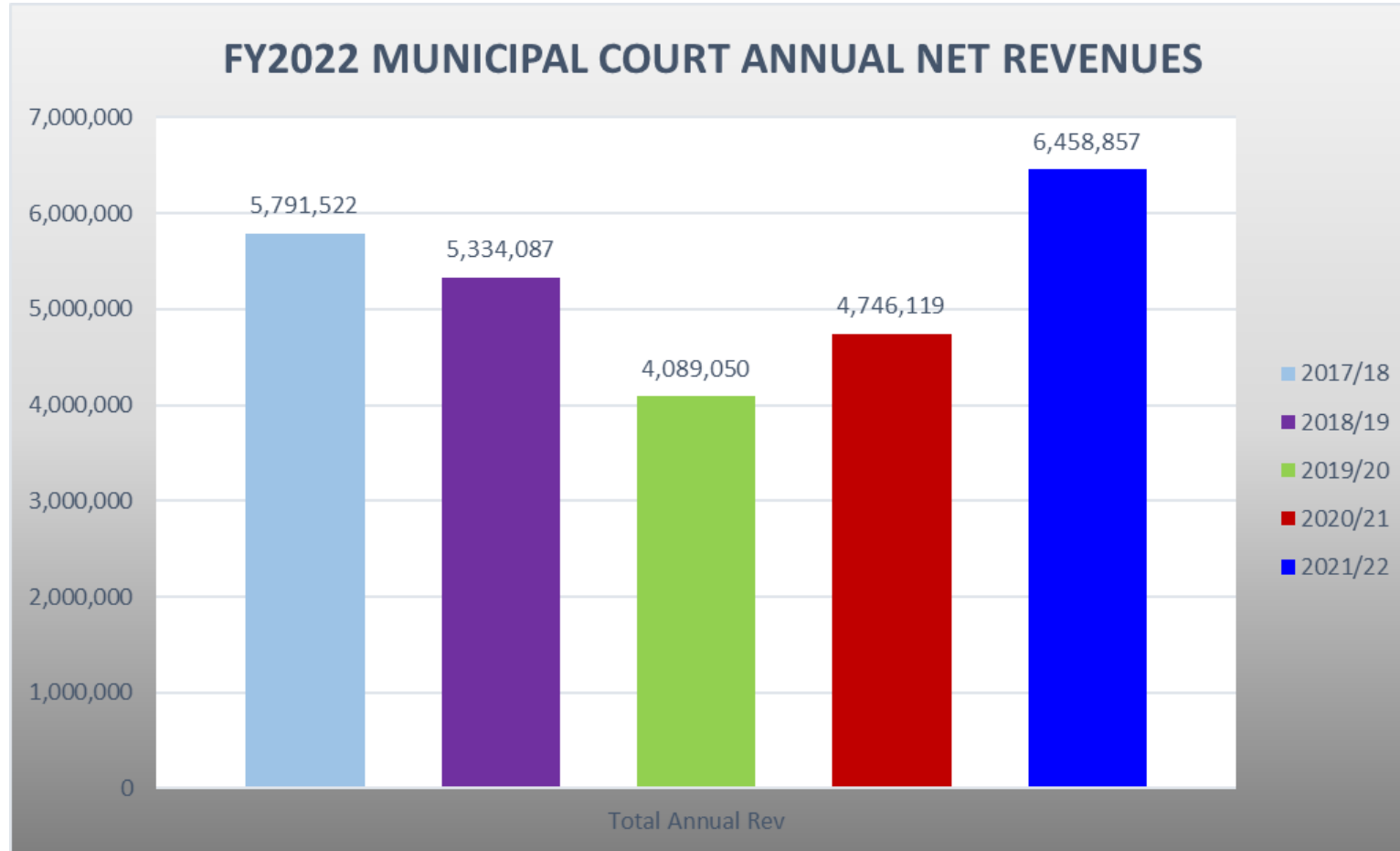


Annual Gross Revenues
