Attached for your signature is the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) form HUD-40093a increasing the City's HOME Investment Partnerships Program – American Rescue Plan (HOME-ARP) grant award by \$6,329. This increase brings the total award from \$4,213,937 to \$4,220,266. This is a 0.15 percent (less than one percent) increase in award funds caused by an administrative error in the federal allocation formula.

HUD notified the City of the increase on June 4, 2025, and has requested the signed form be returned by June 11, 2025. The timeline does not provide adequate notice to present the additional funds to City Council for acceptance and appropriation before the form's required submission. Staff have discussed this with the City Attorney's Office and Finance and Procurement. It has been agreed that the increase in award funds can be presented to City Council for ratification at an upcoming City Council meeting. The July 24, 2025, meeting is the target meeting. Due to the small amount of the increase in the award (0.15 percent of the original), it does not trigger a Substantial Amendment to the City's Annual Action Plan or Council action on the subrecipient awards.

HOME-ARP funds are required to benefit individuals or families who are homeless, at-risk of homelessness, fleeing or attempting to flee domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, stalking, or human trafficking, other populations where providing supportive services or assistance would prevent the family's homelessness or serve those with the greatest risk of housing instability, and veterans and families that include a veteran family member that meet one of the preceding criteria. Funds must be expended by September 30, 2030.

City Council awarded HOME-ARP funds to agencies on March 25, 2025. The increase will be added to the tenant based rental assistance portion of the award. Awards for services are shown below:
