

Ordinance appropriating \$115,000 from the Fleet Maintenance Services Reserve for Future Fleet Replacement Fund No. 5110 into the Capital Outlay Budget of the Maintenance Services Fund No. 5110 for the purchase of vehicles to be used by Development Services; changing the FY 2012-2013 Operating Budget adopted by Ordinance No. 029577 by increasing appropriations by \$115,000 in the No. 5110 Maintenance Services Fund; and approving the purchase of thirty-nine (39) pickup trucks, two (2) cargo vans, six (6) heavy trucks and the lease purchase of two (2) heavy trucks and one (1) pickup truck from AutoNation Ford, Corpus Christi, Texas, in accordance with Bid Invitation No. BI-0146-13, for the total amount of \$1,229,148.00.

Now therefore, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Corpus Christi, Texas:

Section 1. That \$115,000 is appropriated from the Fleet Maintenance Services Reserve for Future Fleet Replacement Fund No. 5110 into the Capital Outlay Budget of the Maintenance Services Fund No. 5110 for the purchase of vehicles to be used by Development Services.

Section 2. That the FY 2012-2013 Operating Budget adopted by Ordinance No. 029577 is changed by increasing appropriations by \$115,000 in the No. 5110 Maintenance Services Fund.

Section 3. That the following purchases are approved: purchase of thirty-nine (39) pickup trucks, two (2) cargo vans, six (6) heavy trucks and the lease purchase of two (2) heavy trucks and one (1) pickup truck from AutoNation Ford, Corpus Christi, Texas, in accordance with Bid Invitation No. BI-0146-13, for the total amount of \$1,229,148.00.
