#### **Grant Information**

The Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant Program is a \$550 million grant program funded through the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law and the Department of Energy.

It is designed to assist States, Local Governments, and Tribes in implementing strategies to reduce energy use, to reduce fossil fuel emissions, and to improve energy efficiency.

The City of Corpus Christi has a formula allotment of \$322,260.00 for the replacement of current lighting with energy efficient lighting.



## Background Information

Under the direction of City Leadership, the Grants Division created the Strategic Conservation Sustainability Planning Team (SCSPT), a team of representatives from all city departments tasked with designing and promoting initiatives to spur greater gains in efficiency and sustainable practices, including grants and programs.

The SCSPT voted to focus on retrofits and upgrades for lighting projects already under consideration by the city. The projects were reviewed for eligibility, then compiled into a list and voted on by the SCSPT.



### Projects Chosen

If awarded, the funding will provide financial assistance for energy efficiency upgrades to the following areas:

- Corpus Christi International Airport (CCIA) Fire Station Building
- CCIA hangar lane
- CCIA International Drive
- CCIA parking lot canopy
- CCIA apron
- Bill Witt Dog Park
- Bill Witt parking lot
- Joe Garza Recreation Center
- Oso Recreation Center
