

CORPUS CHRISTI AQUIFER STORAGE AND RECOVERY CONSERVATION DISTRICT

Three (3) vacancies with terms to 12-31-2021 and 12-31-2023. *(Historically City Staff has served on the board. City Manager Peter Zanoni is recommending the appointments of, Michael Murphy, Amber Oetting and the reappointment of Dan McGinn).*

Duties

The Corpus Christi Aquifer Storage and Recovery Conservation District develops and protects municipal aquifer storage areas created by the City of Corpus Christi. The district may implement and develop aquifer storage and recovery projects.

Composition

Five (5) directors appointed by the City Council to serve four-year staggered terms. If a vacancy occurs on the board, the board may appoint a director to serve the remainder of the term. The board shall annually elect officers and officers must be confirmed by the City Council. The initial directors shall draw lots to determine which three (3) directors shall serve four-year terms that expire at the end of the calendar year four years after the effective date of the Act, and which two directors shall serve two-year terms that expire at the end of the calendar year two years after the effective date of the Act.
