ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE A LEASE-PURCHASE AND OPERATING AGREEMENT INCLUDING OPTION TO PURCHASE WITH TEXAS STATE AQUARIUM ASSOCIATION ("TSAA") COVERING LOTS A-1, A-3, B, C AND D, OF THE TEXAS STATE AQUARIUM TOGETHER WITH LEASEHOLD RIGHTS FOR THE SUBDIVISION. ADJACENT **PARKING** AREAS; IN CONSIDERATION OF MAINTAINING THE PREMISES AND IMPROVEMENTS, OPERATING A PUBLIC AQUARIUM AND RELATED FACILITIES, TSAA'S PAYMENTS ON DEBT SERVICE ON THE 1996 \$4.4 MILLION COMBINATION TAX AND REVENUE CERTIFICATES OF OBLIGATION, AND TSA'S \$45 MILLION DOLLAR EXPANSION OF THE AQUARIUM FACILITY; PROVIDING FOR SEVERANCE: AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The City Manager, or his designee, is authorized to execute a 50-year lease-Purchase and Operating Agreement including option to purchase with Texas State Aquarium Association covering Lots A-1, A-3, B, C, and D of the Texas State Aquarium Subdivision, together with leasehold rights for the adjacent parking areas in consideration of TSAA's maintaining the premises and improvements, operating a public aquarium and related facilities, TSAA's payments on debt service on the 1996 \$4.4 million combination tax and revenue certificates of obligation, and TSAA's \$45 million dollar expansion of the current facilities. A copy of the agreement shall be filed with the City Secretary.

SECTION 2. If, for any reason, any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, word, or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by final judgment of a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect any other section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, word or provision of this ordinance, for it is the definite intent of the City Council that every section, paragraph, subdivision, phrase, word and provision hereof shall be given full force and effect for its purpose.

SECTION 3. Publication shall be made in the official publication of the City of Corpus Christi as required by the City Charter of the City of Corpus Christi. This agreement takes effect on the 61st day following final City Council approval.
