Background Information

Each year, the Law Enforcement Officer Standards and Education account issues an annual allocation of funds to law enforcement agencies, per the Texas Occupations Code, Section 1701.157.

The amount of funds received depends on the number of sworn personnel that a law enforcement agency has as of January 1 of each year and on the available funding in the Law Enforcement Officer Standards and Education account.

The City has received an annual allotment of \$53,897.31.



Background Information

This grant will provide funding for:

The Corpus Christi Police Department (CCPD) will use the funds received from the Law Enforcement Officer Standards and Education account for continued educational training and travelrelated costs for training of sworn police officers.

Police officers are required to have 40 hours of continuing education training on a biannual basis. The training schools include homicide investigation, interrogation techniques, and other police-related subjects.

The City has received this grant since 2002. Last year, CCPD received \$54,134.93.
