HOME-ARP Grant Awards





Federal Funding

- From the American Rescue Plan Act, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) awarded \$4,213,937 in one-time funds to the City
- HOME-ARP funds must be used to benefit the following qualifying populations:
 - Persons who are homeless
 - Persons at risk of homelessness
 - Those fleeing or attempting to flee, domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, stalking or human trafficking
 - Other populations where providing supportive services or assistance would prevent the family's homelessness or serve those with the greatest risk of housing instability
- City is awarding funds based on a competitive grant application process.
