Resolution authorizing an interlocal agreement with Bexar Metro 9-1-1 Network for business continuity, with a five-year term and five one-year renewal options, at an annual cost of \$28,800.00.

WHEREAS, the City of Corpus Christi ("City") has a need for business continuity;

WHEREAS, Bexar Metro 9-1-1 Network ("Bexar Metro"), a Texas emergency communication district created as a political subdivision of the State of Texas via confirmation election pursuant to Chapter 772, Texas Health and Safety Code, can satisfy the City's governmental need; and

WHEREAS, the City and Bexar Metro are authorized by Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code to enter into an interlocal cooperation agreement to accomplish the stated purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS:

An interlocal cooperation agreement ("Agreement") between the City and Bexar Metro 9-1-1 Network is authorized for business continuity purposes, with a five-year term and five one-year renewal options, at an annual cost to the City of \$28,800.00; and the City Manager, or his designee, is authorized to execute the Agreement.
