

Motion to Determine if City Staff is to Evaluate a Business Proposal for Future Brackish Water Supply Developed by Seven Seas Water Group

BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE

- Seven Seas Water Group is the original and leading Public-Private Partnership (P3) provider of Water-as-a-Service® system owning more than 220 water and wastewater treatment plants
- This project would deliver a minimum of 10 million gallons a day (MGD) with the expectation up to 20 MGD
- The final size of the project will be dictated by aquifer testing which will inform the long-term sustainable production possible from this portion of the aquifer.
- The Council previously authorized staff to work with STWA and Seven Seas Water Group on a brackish reverse osmosis project in Nueces County.



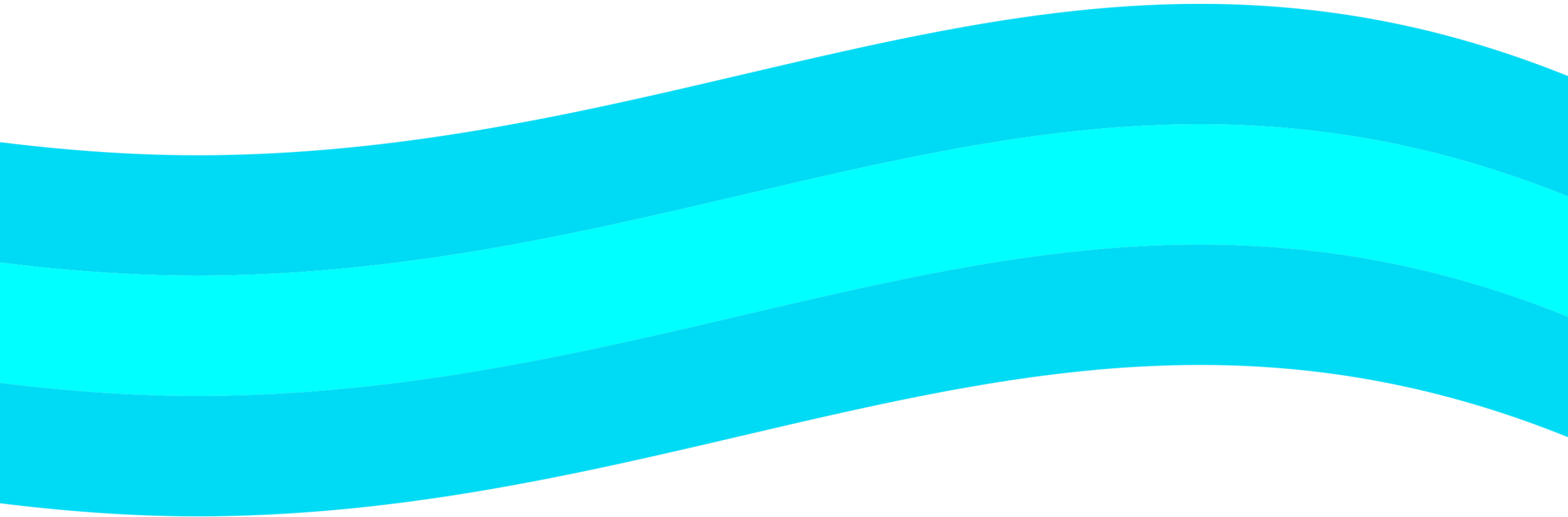
LOCATION
