By-Laws Update

December 16, 2025

By-law revisions approved by the CBCOG Board of Directors on December 11, 2025:

- The Council shall elect officers at the December meeting Section 5a
- Advisory member representatives will be elected to the Executive Board at the first meeting of the year Section 6a
- The Council shall meet at minimum six (6) times per year Section 7a
- Agenda packets will be delivered electronically Section 7d
- The Executive Board shall meet quarterly Section 11a
- A quorum will be determined by a simple majority of Board of Directors Attachment A



Board of Directors Representation

- Each County is allotted 2 official representatives.
- Each incorporated City receives a minimum of 1 official representative.
- Cities with over 20,000 population receive 1 additional representative.
- Cities with over 50,000 population receive 2 additional representatives.
- Cities with over 100,000 population receive 3 additional representatives.
