Background Information

Plains All American Pipeline owns and operates midstream energy infrastructure and provides logistics services for crude oil, natural gas liquids, and natural gas.

Plains All American Pipeline has long demonstrated its commitment to giving back to the community through the CARE Program and First Responder Grant. This grant program is a grant opportunity that provides safety equipment and professional training to first responders such as CCFD.

The City of Corpus Christi has received an award of \$5,037.00.



Background Information

This grant will provide funding for:

The grant funds will be used to purchase one new Environmental Device Haz-Dust Real-Time Dust Monitor for CCFD's HAZMAT response team in the amount of approximately \$5,000.

This device identifies hazardous particulates and quantifies the parts per million so that HAZMAT response teams can better assess and respond to HAZMAT situations. The ability to measure numerous types of aerosols and dust will provide much-needed additional safety for CCFD personnel.
