Project Description




- AEP's 69 kV overhead transmission line is in conflict with the proposed Mary Rhodes Phase 2 sedimentation basin
- The 69 kV line will be temporarily raised and relocated outside of the limits of the sedimentation basin in February, 2014
- The 69 kV line will be permanently raised or routed around the sedimentation basin in November 2014
