- September 17, 2013
City Council appropriated funds for Strike Force
 - October 21, 2013
Limited operations begin
 - Fall 2013 and Winter 2014
Vehicle and equipment purchases
Team recruitment, hiring, training
 - April 2014
Full complement of staff
Vehicles delivered
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Operational Summary



- Crew

 - Four park operations technicians

 - Two vehicles

 - Mowing equipment

 - Small construction and repair equipment

- System

 - Inspection Routes

 - 53 individual routes

 - Minor repairs, brush, trash addressed along the way

 - Coordination with operating departments, outside agencies

Planned Work Orders Completed	11	18	29
Response Work Orders Completed	10	19	29

Overgrown medians

Damaged/Vandalized signs and public property

Special projects – downtown, North Beach

Special event preparation - Agnes/Laredo Corridor Clean Up



Opportunities



- **Inter Department Cooperation**

 - Streets – report pot holes or other concerns

 - Storm Water – report dumping or debris in ditches

 - Code Enforcement/Police Department – report ordinances violations

- **Intra Agency Cooperation**

 - Texas Department of Transportation – Harbor Bridge landings

 - Corpus Christi Independent School District – reported concerns

 - Downtown Management District – Downtown Cleanups
