Resolution authorizing an Advance Funding Agreement with the Texas Department of Transportation (TXDOT) for the Ocean Drive Pedestrian Crossing Improvement Project for infrastructure improvements to include a pedestrian hybrid beacon on Oleander Point at Cole Park with the City's payment of \$8,354.00 to TXDOT for direct state costs, located in Council District 2, with FY 2025 funding from ARPA interest.

WHEREAS, the estimated project cost for State Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside (TASA) Program for the Ocean Drive Pedestrian Crossing Improvement Project is \$479,220.00. Federal participation is \$367,570.00, state participation is \$19,757.00 and City participation is estimated to be \$91,893.00. The City is responsible for 100% of cost overruns.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee (Director of Engineering Service) is authorized to execute an Advance Funding Agreement (AFA) for the Ocean Drive Pedestrian Crossing Improvement Project with the City's payment to TXDOT in the amount of \$8,354.00 for reimbursement of direct state costs.

SECTION 2. The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute all related documents necessary to administer said AFA, including minor amendments thereto.
