That City Council Policy No. 16 n. regarding Motion to Reconsider is amended to delete the struck through text and insert the underlined text as follows:

16. - Conduct of meetings; rules of procedure.

Any member of the Council who voted with the prevailing side on any question may move its reconsideration no later than the next regular meeting; reconsideration shall require a two-thirds vote of the Council. The fact that a failed action is subject to such motion being made at the next regular meeting does not prevent it from being brought up as new business at or before the next regular meeting. A motion to reconsider is governed by the most current edition of Robert's Rules of Order, and the motion to reconsider may only be made before the end of the meeting.~~
