## Public Works

I am pleased to announce that I am appointing Ernesto De La Garza, P.E., as Director of Public Works, effective Monday, November 7.

Ernesto has 20 years of street and bridge construction and transportation engineering experience, 14 of which were with TxDOT. Most of his experience has been in Corpus Christi and the Coastal Bend region. He recently served as the Contract Claim Section Lead for TxDOT in Corpus Christi.
