




Parks and Recreation North Beach Renourishment Project

North Beach Renourishment Project 2026

- North Beach is experiencing significant shoreline erosion
- To address the City pursued an emergency grant through the Texas General Land Office (TXGLO)
- TXGLO has reviewed and approved the emergency application under the Beach Monitoring and Maintenance Plan (BMMP)
- Proposed project will renourish approximately 3,500 linear feet of North Beach to restore shoreline protection and public use

North Beach Renourishment Project 2026

- Project Scope
 - Placement of 75,000–80,000 cubic yards of beach-quality sand
 - Restores beach width and protects backshore infrastructure
- Estimated Total Project Cost: \$6.53 million
 - Construction, sand placement, surveys, and mobilization
 - Includes contingency and \$300,000 for engineering services
- Funding
 - Full local match waiver requested due to emergency conditions
 - The North Beach renourishment project has been approved for funding by the TXGLO.
 - City has not yet been notified of the award amount
- Next Steps
 - Execute project agreement between TXGLO and the City
 - Coordinate construction to avoid peak tourism season
 - Apply for the Coastal Erosion Planning and Response Act (CEPRA) grant every 2 years (Cycle)
 - A project kickoff meeting with TXGLO and City staff is scheduled for February 18 (WebEx)
