Background Information

This Resolution authorizes the submission of a grant application for \$894,028.00 to the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority to continue the Motor Vehicle Theft Unit activities in the Corpus Christi Police Department.

The City of Corpus Christi is requesting \$1,856,494.00 with a City cash match of \$191,860.00 and 770,606.00 for in-kind services .



Background Information

This grant will provide funding for:

The grant provides funds for one Lieutenant to supervise the Auto Theft Task Force unit, consisting of three additional sworn CCPD officers and three civilians (seven total employees).

As part of the Auto Theft Task Force unit, the civilians conduct data analysis, crime analysis, manage the required public awareness campaign, provide customer service to victims of auto crime, and maintain grant paperwork.



Background Information

The grant period will be from September 1, 2025, through August 31, 2026.

The City has received this grant for 25 years. Last year, the City received \$864,614 from this grant.
