

### **Other Bills Not on Priorities List (as of 5/19/13)**

- HB 912 – Unmanned Aerial System privacy – Passed by Senate. House can concur or go to conference committee.
- HB 1025 – Supplemental Appropriations Bill (includes funding for Cedar Bayou) – Approved by Senate Finance. Must pass Senate by 5/22/13.
- HB 1250 – Eminent domain (original purpose for purchase) – Died in House Calendars
- HB 1719 – Airport passenger screening – Died in committee
- HB 1736 – Property tax break for facilities that convert landfill methane into natural gas – In Senate Finance
- HB 2334 – Brackish/seawater desalination permitting – Died on House Calendar
- HB 2416 – Bag Freedom Bill – died in Calendars
- HB 2420 – Prohibits assessing civil penalties for right turn violations captured by a traffic camera – Died in House Calendars
- HB 2421 – Prohibit vehicle registration hold for non-payment traffic fines – Died in committee
- HB 2741 – Motor vehicle registration and regulation – Passed Senate. House can concur or go to conference committee
- HB 2828 – oil and gas pipeline ordinances – Died in committee
- HB 2934 – Electronic communications in public meetings – Died in committee
- HB 3165 - require signage next to a red light camera – Died in committee
- HB 3304 - Prohibit vehicle registration hold for non-payment of red light offenses – Died in committee
- HB 3429 – Transportation of fireworks – Died in committee
- HB 3769 - impose a civil penalty for certain parking violations – Pending in Senate Intergovernmental Relations Committee.
- HB 3822 – Prohibit inter-local contracts to purchase energy – Died in committee
- HB 3831 – Naming section of SH 358 Peace Officer Memorial Highway – Recommended for Senate Local and Uncontested Calendar.
- SB 14 – Fiscal Transparency and Accountability – On House Calendar 5/21/13.
- SB 645 – Bottle recycling – Died in committee
- SB 923 – Tap fee bill – Died in committee
- SB 1563 – Definition and access to public information – Approved by House committee. Committee paperwork must have been completed by 5/18/13. Outcome uncertain.
