Summary & Background

Acceptance of the Revised Notice of Award for the Women, Infants and Children (WIC) Program which in the amount of \$24,100

- The grant award is to be used to provide for personnel costs, supplies, and other expenses to offer WIC services and associated activities related to the WIC program within the jurisdiction of the Corpus Christi-Nueces County Public Health District (CCNCPHD).
- This amendment will increase the grant award by \$24,100 for grant funding period.
- Texas WIC helps improve the diets of infants and children as well as pregnant, postpartum, and breastfeeding women by providing monthly healthy food packages, nutrition counseling, education and breastfeeding support.

Fiscal Impact and Staff Recommendation

Fiscal impact

- No fiscal impact as the WIC program is 100% grant funded.
- The total amount of the grant award will increase from \$1,118,493 to \$1,142,593.
- The award includes an indirect cost allocation of 22.39% of direct salaries and wages.
- The funding increase will not change current FTE levels.
