



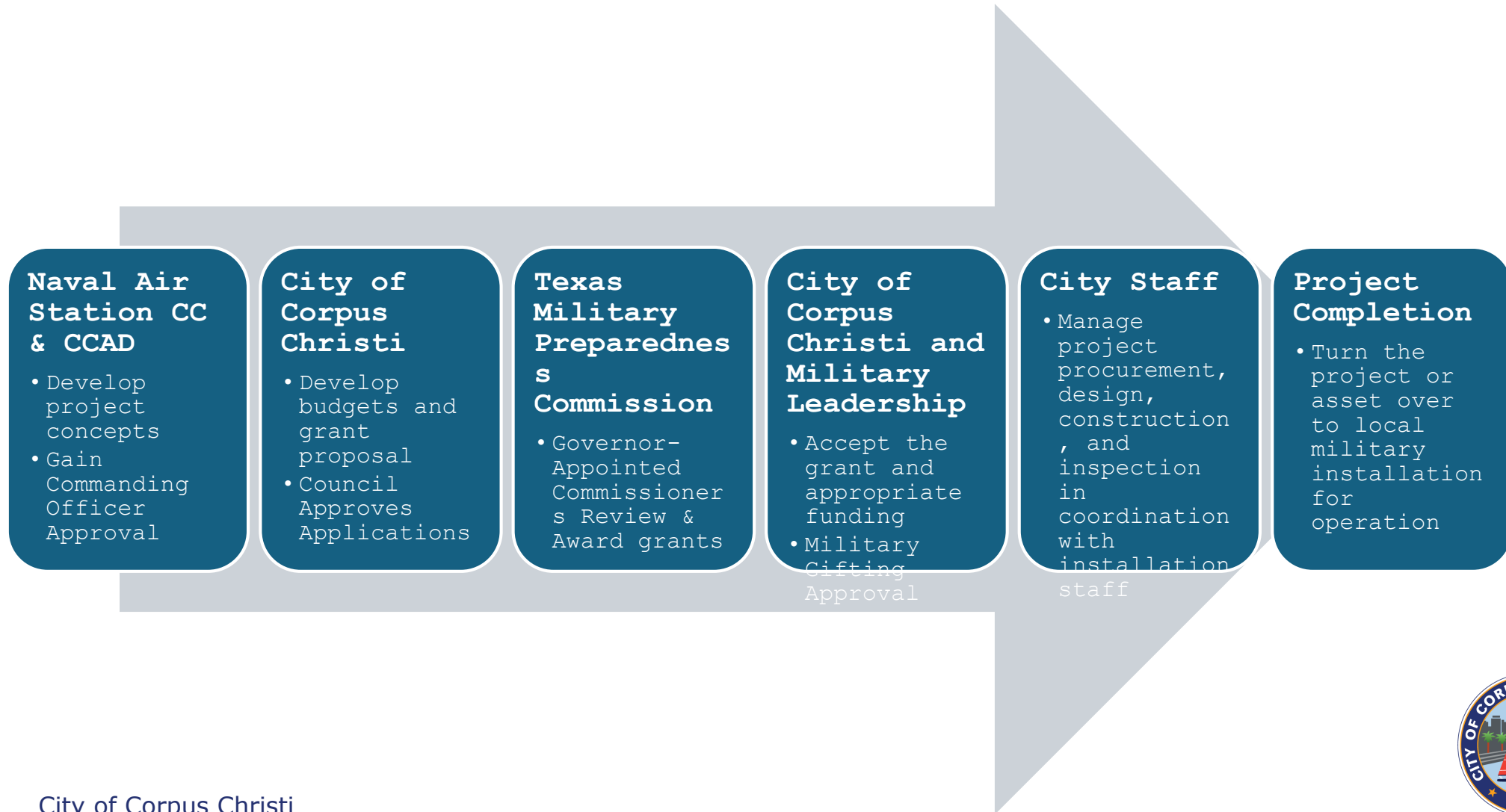
Completion of Defense Economic Adjustment Assistance Grant (DEAAG) Projects at Naval Air Station Corpus Christi

Defense Economic Adjustment Assistance Grant Program (DEEAG)

- DEEAG is an infrastructure grant designed to support defense communities affected by the reduction or termination of defense contracts, as well as those benefiting from new or expanded military missions and job retention.



DEAAG Process



DEAAG Program in Corpus Christi

- Since 2017, the City, alongside legislative and local supporters, has secured over \$12.7 million in state funding for NAS Corpus Christi and the Corpus Christi Army Depot.
- In 2026, the Texas Military Preparedness Commission approved two new DEAAG grants totaling \$3.06 million, pending City Council approval upon receipt of the agreements from the Office of the Governor.

Security Fence Replacement

- The grant was awarded in September 2023, with project permission granted in January 2025, design starting in March 2025, and construction completed by March 2026.
- The \$1.2 million project replaced a non-functional gate and 13,500 linear feet of corroded chain link fence.
- The new fence and gate enhance security compliance with Department of Defense standards.
- The City contributed \$123,000 for project management.



Naval Air Station Corpus Christi

Wastewater Line Replacement

- The grant was awarded in April 2023, with design starting in June 2024 and construction completed by June 2026.
- The \$4.9 million project replaced 4,948 linear feet of old clay pipes with poly/composite lines and 21 manholes.
- This upgrade enhances the wastewater collection system, minimizing repairs, maximizing capacity, and ensuring compliance with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.
- The City contributed \$387,000 in project management services.



Ongoing & Future DEAAG Projects

Ongoing and future DEAAG projects will build on the prior investment by the TMPC at NAS Corpus Christi and CCAD. The following projects have been approved by the TMPC:

- NAS CC Lifts Station Replacement
- NAS CC Wastewater Line Replacement 2.0
- CCAD Condensate Return Stations Replacement
- CCAD Atmospheric Water Generation Units
