Floodwall Upgrades at the Corpus Christi Museum of Science and History

- The Capital Improvement Project for Floodwall Upgrades at the Corpus Christi Museum of Science and History was approved during the June 8, 2026, Corpus Christi B Corporation Board meeting.
- This item is being presented to hold the required public hearing and provide an opportunity for public comment on the project.
- The project includes construction of a new floodwall and bulkhead extending from the existing Corpus Christi Ship Channel overlook east of the Harbor Bridge to the western extent of the City's existing seawall at the Art Museum of South Texas.
- A public hearing for the use of Type B funds must be held before funds may be expended. Funds cannot be expended until 60 days after the public hearing.
- Total FY 2027 Type B Funding: \$4,255,000
