

**Resolution authorizing submission of grant application for \$47,393.76 to the State of Texas for the salary and benefits of one full-time employee under the Violence Against Women Act with City cash match of \$13,351.61 and \$6,960.00 for in-kind services.**

**Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Corpus Christi, Texas:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Council authorizes submission of the grant application to the State of Texas, Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division in the amount of \$47,393.76 for funding available under the Violence Against Women Act (VAWA) Fund for the Police Department's Family Violence Unit to continue the Victim Outreach Program.

**SECTION 2.** The City Council commits to provide for the applicable city match of \$13,351.61 cash and \$6,960 in-kind services.

**SECTION 3.** The City Manager or the City Manager's designee may apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant.

**SECTION 4.** In the event of the loss or misuse of these Office of the Governor funds, the City of Corpus Christi assures that the funds will be returned to the State of Texas, Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division in full.
