 - New process to award design consultants for all projects at one time
 - More project management and oversight during delivery

- Mass RFQ's issued to begin process of selection early
 - All RFQ's to be closed by December 7
 - Review process of RFQs will take approximately 60 days
 - Contracts to Council for consideration in March 2023
