CCAD Project

 The proposed project is Phase 2 of CCAD's plan to strengthen mission readiness and efficiency while supporting regional water sustainability. Through this project, CCAD will procure and install four atmospheric water generators. These generators will contribute 8,800 gallons of water each day towards CCAD's critical industrial processes. By producing water on-site, CCAD will reduce reliance on external supply, increase resilience to drought and infrastructure disruptions, and align with Department of Defense goals for sustainability and resource efficiency.
