

Provision and Sale of Recycled Water Agreement

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Overview

Ordinance authorizing a Reclaimed Water Supply Agreement and associated License for Use of Premises with Flint Hills Resources (FHR) Corpus Christi, LLC for the sale and delivery of reclaimed water from the Allison Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP)

- Phased implementation
 - Reservation Phase
 - FHR pays monthly volume commitment fees based on the Reclaimed Water Rate
 - First year of this fee is waived
 - Pilot Phase
 - Phase 1
 - FHR will install trailer-mounted processing equipment in a designated area at the WWTP to support processing of up to 1.0 million gallons per day (MGD)
 - Phase 2
 - Expand to additional 2.0 MGD per day



Project Benefits

- Places the financial burden of infrastructure and operational costs on FHR rather than the City
 - FHR is responsible for all infrastructure, permitting, and operational costs associated with receiving and processing the reclaimed water, including the installation of a City-approved meter that the City will own and maintain
 - Additional treatment costs incurred by the City due to the Company's operations are reimbursable
- Reduces reliance on potable water supplies and supports sustainable water management practices
