

**Resolution authorizing submission of grant application for \$59,609.00 to the State of Texas Criminal Justice Division under the Violence Against Women Act Fund for the salary and benefits of one civilian position in the Corpus Christi Police Department's Family Violence Unit, with a City cash match of \$20,810.00 cash and \$6,960.00 for in-kind services.**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Council authorizes submission of the grant application to the State of Texas Criminal Justice Division in the amount of \$59,609.00 for funding available under the Violence Against Women Act (VAWA) Fund.

**SECTION 2.** The City Council commits to provide for the applicable City match of \$20,810.00 cash and \$6,960.00 in-kind services.

**SECTION 3.** The City Council designates the Chief of Police as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official may apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant.

**SECTION 4.** In the event of the loss or misuse of these Office of the Governor funds, the City of Corpus Christi assures that the funds will be returned to the State of Texas Criminal Justice Division in full.
