

**Resolution authorizing the City Manager or designee to submit a grant application in the amount of \$681,248 to the Automobile Burglary Theft Prevention Authority (ABTPA) to continue the motor vehicle theft enforcement grant within the Police Department for Year 12 with a City cash match of \$503,003, in-kind match of \$14,019, and program income match of \$8,541 for a total project cost of \$1,206,811 and authorizing the City Manager or the City Manager's designee to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant.**

**Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Corpus Christi, Texas:**

**Section 1.** The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to submit a grant application in the amount of \$681,248 to the Automobile Burglary Theft Prevention Authority (ABTPA) to continue the motor vehicle theft enforcement grant within the Police Department for Year 12 with a City cash match of \$503,003, in-kind match of \$14,019, and program income match of \$8,541 for a total project cost of \$1,206,811, and to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant.

**Section 2.** In the event of the loss or misuse of these funds, the City of Corpus Christi assures that the funds will be returned, in full, to the Automobile Theft Prevention Authority.
