



AGREEMENT

This Agreement between the City of Corpus Christi ("City") and Saltwater-fisheries Enhancement Association ("Agency") is effective upon execution by City Manager and will terminate on December 31, 2011.

1. Statement of work to be performed: At State Boat Ramp SBF 69-16-167-178, known as Clem's and Billing's Boat Ramp, located on Packery Channel under the JFK Causeway in Nueces County, the City of Corpus Christi shall complete engineered design plans and specifications, required permits and clearances to renovate the boat ramps, bulkhead and associated parking area. Agency will share in the cost of the renovation of the boat ramps, bulkhead and associated parking area.
2. Agency shall make payment of reimbursable costs of \$25,000 to City in accordance with its letter dated September 28, 2009. Agency shall make payments for the purposes described in paragraph 1 above. Payment shall be billed upon completion of work, and paid by Agency within 30 days of date of invoice.
3. The undersigned parties do hereby certify and agree that (1) the work specified above is necessary and essential for activities that are properly within the statutory functions and programs of the affected parties, (2) the proposed arrangements serve the interest of efficient and economical administration of the parties, and (3) the individuals whose approval signatures are affixed to this agreement are duly authorized by the governing body of each part to enter into and execute this agreement.
