DETAILS

COMPOSITION

The Regional Health Awareness Board is made up of fifteen (15) voting members representing a cross-section of health, environmental, and social interest. Two (2) community members will be appointed by the City Council, two (2) community members appointed by the Nueces County Commissioner's Court , and two (2) community members appointed by the San Patricio County Commissioner's Court for three-year terms. At-large members are appointed to three-year terms as follows: 1 - City of Corpus Christi, 1 - Nueces County, 1 - San Patricio County, 2 - Port Industries of Corpus Christi, 1 - Texas A & M - Corpus Christi, and 1 - Texas A & M - Kingsville. Also, 1 - member appointed by the Irma Lerma Rangel College of Pharmacy and 1 - member appointed by the Education Service Center, Region 2 for three-year terms beginning in January. Additionally, there are four (4) ex-officio/non-voting representatives, one (1) from each of the following agencies: Texas Commission on Environmental Quality, Environmental Protection Agency, Nueces County/City of Corpus Christi Public Health District and San Patricio County Department of Public Health.
