# Background Information

The JAG funds are based on Part 1 violent crimes reported by the City and County. The City reports a greater amount of Part 1 crimes than the County, yet the County is responsible for providing criminal justice services such as incarceration and prosecution for the City. Because of this, the City has agreed to split the funds 50/50 with Nueces County, which has been in place since 2008.

The City of Corpus Christi is applying for \$212,068.00, if awarded, the Police Department will split the funds with Nueces County.

# Background Information

The funds awarded in 2025 will be used to partially pay year 4 of the 5-year taser agreement for 445 tasers for the Corpus Christi Police Department

Grant funds will be appropriated in the FY26 Police Grants budget.

# Background Information

This grant is for a one-year period beginning October 1, 2026, through September 30, 2027.

With this award, the program has provided a total of \$6,574,847.00 in grant funds to the City since the program began in 1996. In previous years, the funds have been used to purchase vehicles and other law enforcement equipment.
