Project Scope



- U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Federal Government and City is conducting a feasibility study for streambank erosion control related to the Mary Rhodes Pipeline Phase 2 System Improvements.
- The overall cost of the feasibility study is estimated to be at \$450,000.
- Federal Government funded the first \$100,000 and the remaining cost has to be split between U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and City. The City's share is estimated at \$175,000.
- On March 30, 2021, City Council authorized \$92,500 for the feasibility study.
- This item will authorize the remaining funds in an amount of \$82,500 required to complete the feasibility study.
- The project feasibility began in April 2021 and the final report is scheduled to be completed by August of 2022.
