Create a Dynamic, Integrated Water Development Plan (2050)


- Establish schedule & priorities for water development projects
- Promote conservation & reuse of existing water
- Involve regional partnerships
- Create an equitable & fair charging mechanism

Recommendations on Water Supply



- Strongly support completion of Mary Rhodes Pipeline (MRP) Phase II
- Possibly use MRP for transport of ground water

Recommendations on Water Supply



- Variable source due to water rights, water quality, aquifer size, land ownership & permitting
- Investigate aquifer storage & recharge
- May be a backup supply source during drought
- Desalination on brackish ground water



Recommendations on



- Practically an unlimited source
- Important for the long term
- Economics very site specific
 - Expensive; energy costs and capital investments
 - Cooperative approaches
 - **OBrine disposal**
 - Corpus Christi area has favorable characteristics
