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I am pleased to inform you that the Texas Parks and Wildlife Boating Access Committee met, and your boating access project was recommended to receive grant funding. Congratulations on submitting such a worthy project proposal.

The next step is for Texas Parks and Wildlife to submit your proposal into the federal system for final approval. We are forwarding copies of your project application to the Texas Parks & Wildlife Habitat Assessment staff to review the potential impacts to natural resources. Once the review is complete, and I have approval through the federal system for your project to proceed, I will issue your boating access local grant agreement to execute through the Recreation Grants Online (RGO) system. A Teams meeting will be set up to discuss the process going forward.

No construction is allowed with this grant agreement. We will not reimburse you for any work or funds spent prior to receipt of the local project agreement.
