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## **Robot Camera System Closed Circuit Television (CCTV)**

#### **CAPTION:**

Motion authorizing the purchase of a new robotic camera system closed circuit television from Texas Underground, Inc., of Pearland, Texas, for \$91,760.00, with FY 2023 funding from the Storm Water CIP Fund.

#### **SUMMARY:**

This purchase will allow Storm Water crews the ability to inspect/investigate underground storm water pipes and manholes from the safety of ground level.

## **BACKGROUND AND FINDINGS:**

Public Works currently maintains and operates approximately 682 linear miles of underground storm water pipes. Pipes range in size from 12" to 10'x10' box culverts and range in material type from Clay to Reinforced Concrete. There is a need to inspect/investigate these lines during emergency and non-emergency operations.

This fiscal year Storm Water has had over 100 work orders for maintenance of lines operations that require some type of investigation prior to beginning repairs. Most of the time this comes in the form of a confined spaced entry. While we are properly trained to perform this operation the element of danger still exists.

The benefits of this purchase will improve investigation time due to the deletion of a confined space entry, increase the detail of the assessment of the pipe and increase safety of our crews.

## **PROCUREMENT DETAIL:**

Finance & Procurement issued a Request for Bid and received two responsive, responsible bids and two no bids out of 247 notifications for the purchase of a new robotic camera system closed circuit television (CCTV), and staff is recommending the award to Texas Underground, Inc., of Pearland, Texas.
