

Resolution supporting a proposed amendment to the Coastal Bend Council of Governments (CBCOG) bylaws reducing board director positions, as recommended by CBCOG Executive Director Emily Martinez

Whereas, CBCOG Executive Director Emily Martinez is recommending amending the CBCOG bylaws to reduce the number of board director positions by proportionally allocating seats on the CBCOG Board to counties and cities based on their population brackets, with a maximum of 4 seats per governmental entity.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The City Council supports the proposed amendment to the Coastal Bend Council of Governments (CBCOG) bylaws to reduce the number of board director positions by proportionally allocating seats on the CBCOG Board to counties and cities based on their population brackets, with the maximum number of seats being capped at 4 per governmental entity, providing counties with one representative for every 20,000 citizens or a fraction thereof, and providing cities with one representative for the first 15,000 and an additional representative for each additional 35,000 citizens or fraction thereof.
