

Resolution authorizing the City Manager, or designee, to execute Amendment No. 2 to Interlocal Cooperation Agreement with Texas A & M University Corpus Christi for the Pollution Partnership Alliance Clean Fleet Program by adding \$140,750.00 for cost reimbursements and extending the term through August 31, 2013; authorizing the City Manager, or designee, to execute Amendment No. 2 to Interlocal Cooperation Agreement with the University of North Texas University for Air Quality Monitoring and Modeling by adding \$184,750.00 for costs reimbursements and extending the term through August 31, 2013.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS:

SECTION 1 The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute Amendment No. 2 to the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for the Pollution Partnership Alliance Clean Fleet Program with Texas A & M University – Corpus Christi by adding up to an additional \$140,750.00 in cost-based reimbursements and extending the term through August 31, 2013.

SECTION 2 The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute Amendment No. 2 to the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for Air Quality Monitoring and Modeling with University of North Texas by adding up to an additional \$184,750.00 in cost-based reimbursements and extending the term through August 31, 2013.
